Value of the Month: Independence



### This week the children will be:

Topic: People who help us.

Value of Independence will be introduced 'have a go'. The children will be encouraged to put their coats on, look after their belongings and try new activities.

Story focus 'Flashing fire engines' by Tony Mitton.

What do fire fighters do? What equipment do they use? What do they wear and why?

Rhyme focus: 'Five little fire fighters standing in a row'. The children will be pointing and counting objects carefully. They will be ordering numerals.

The children will be ordering toys by size tallest/shortest. learning the rhyme and acting out using soft toy props. The children will be comparing the size of the teddies and counting them into sets.

Phonics: The children will be learning the rhyme string 'eg' for example leg, peg, meg.

Our children will be talking about the feeling calm.

We will be listening to music composed by Beethoven. He is our musician of the month.

### **At home you could:**

Share your child's school library book. Name the author. Encourage your child to turn the pages. Look at the front cover and ask them what they think the book is about. Revisit the characters from the story. Listen to some music by Beethoven.
