



## Year 2 Curriculum Newsletter

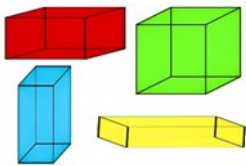
### English



In English, we will continue to work on forming letters, spelling and using a range of punctuation correctly within all their writing. Children will begin by writing instructions for a recipe, they will also be working on creating posters, fact sheets and information pages. They will then develop their writing stamina using Back to Earth with a Bump and Lights on Cotton Rock as a prompt. They will be editing their work and developing their comprehension skills.

In Maths, we will be working on multiplication and division. The children will describe equal groups using stem sentences to support them. It is important that the children know which groups are equal and unequal and why they are equal or unequal. They will connect equal groups to repeated addition. The children will begin to work on multiplication word problems by drawing images to help them solve them. They will be counting and applying their knowledge of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables to solve calculations. Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s

The children will be counting pounds and pence. They will choose notes and coins and make the same amount. They will also calculate with money, make a pound and find change.



### Maths



### Science



In Science this term the children will be learning about our Solar System, phases of the moon and the constellations. They will be developing their observation skills and revisiting habitats in the school grounds to observe changes throughout the year. Finally the children will begin to learn about the properties of different materials.

## Topic

Children will be making moon rocks in cooking. They will be designing and making space vehicles using pivots and axles. In art the children will be exploring a range of art techniques. They will be able to paint or make planets using clay and other materials. We will continue to learn about the Earth and other planets in the Solar System. We will be learning about famous astronauts including the animals that went into space. We will be following current space exploration.

## PE



The children will be moving to music. The children will remember, repeat and link actions to tell the story of their dance. They will use count of 8 to stay in time to the music. To remember, repeat a dance as a group. To copy and repeat yoga poses.

## Computing



In Computing the children will be learning to sort information using yes/no questions. They will design a binary tree binary tree. They will use database to answer questions. The children will use spreadsheets to enter data into a table within a sheet and
