Value of the Month: Independence



This week the children will be:

Topic: People who help us.

Story focus Police Officer by Andrew Askew and Andrew Crowson.

This week the children will be learning about the Police. They will be finding out about how they help us. We will be focusing on looking at police vehicles and animals. In our circle time the children will be thinking about how they can help others. They will also be focusing on how we look after the school and their own property.

Number rhyme linked to the story book: Counting aloud in order. Recognising numerals 1-5 and adding on more. We will be talking about being fair and sharing equally between 2 people.

Phonics session: The children will be developing their listening and memory skills playing copy the body percussion patterns. They will also be playing games to identify initial sounds in words.

In the creative area the children will be creating repeating patterns linked to the topic.

Physical development.

Adults will model drawing objects of interest talking about the shapes in the pictures for example a police car drawing rectangle and circles. When sharing stories we will be using the language 'Where is the?', 'Who is your favourite character?'

At home you could:

Read with your child daily and ask Where and Who questions.

Model drawing straight lines to make a rectangle shape. Can you make it into a fire engine, police car, house?
