Value of the Month: Independence



This week the children will be:

Topic: People who help us.

Story focus *Maisy goes to the hospital* by Lucy Cousins.

The children will listen to the story, retell it using props and then 2D pictures.

This week the children will be learning all about doctors and nurses. They will be talking about how they help us and what they do. The children will help to set up a role play doctors surgery.

Number rhyme *Five fat sausages* - Counting the sausages. Ordering the numbers on the number line. Talk about one less. In our number sessions the children will be making sets of toys and identifying which set has the most/least.

Phonics - Activities linked to 'Doctors'. Children will be looking closely at their names, particularly the initial sound. They will be identifying musical instruments to develop listening skills.

The children will learn the rhyme '*Miss Polly had a dolly*' and clap the beat.

In forest school this week we will be identifying and counting birds for the big school birdwatch. We will be naming bird features.

At home you could:

Share your child's school library book. Name the author. Encourage your child to turn the pages. Look at the front cover and ask them what they think the book is about. Revisit the characters from the story.

Make a number line with numerals one to five and ask your child to match the number of toys next to each numeral for example put one car next to numeral 1, two teddies next to numeral 2, three blocks next to numeral three. Clap the beat to a known song.
