Value of the Month: Not giving up



This week the children will be:

Topic: People who help us.

Stories this week will be told using small world props linked to people who help us. The children will then be encouraged to retell these stories in their play.

Number rhyme: 5 little men in a flying saucer.

Phonics - The children will be clapping syllables in words. They will continue to match rhyming words.

We will be looking at the artist Kandinsky talking about how he used colours and shapes often painting to music which he linked to feelings. The children will paint their own pictures to music thinking about the shapes and colours they are using.

For our topic, the children will be learning about road safety and the Lollipop person. The children will role play crossing the road and remember the rules about staying safe near the road.

Throughout the week we will be sorting items by colour and shape using a range of materials.

At home you could:

Play a rhyming game. I spy with my little eye something that rhymes with boat (coat). Read with your child everyday. Can they point to the writing in the book? Can they point to the pictures/illustrations in the book? Look at the front cover before you begin and ask "What do you think this book is about? Why do you think that?". Look for shapes in the environment. Naming circle, square, triangle and rectangle.
