Value of the Month: Not giving up



This week the children will be:

Topic: New Life

Stories- Spot goes to the farm by Eric Hill
The Pig in the pond by Martin Waddell

Making up stories set on a farm using small world sets. Talking about where the story is set, who is in the story and what happens.

Number rhyme: Our number rhyme will be '5 little ducks'. Focusing on counting forwards and backwards and ordering numerals.

Phonics - Children will be making loud and quiet sounds. They will be listening and identifying initial sounds when talking about farm animals. The children will be learning the sequence of body movements linked to the way animals move. We will be listening to hear the initial sounds of each animal for example 'p' for 'pig'.

Drawing and making farm animals talking about what shapes they are drawing. Naming the animal features legs, tail, eyes, ears, nose, mouth/snout/beak.

At home you could:

Name farm animals and research what their babies are called.

Share your child's school library book. Talking about where the story is set, who is in the story and what happens.
