



## Year 2 Curriculum Newsletter

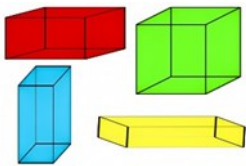


### Summer 26

#### English



In English, we will be reading longer stories and developing children's comprehension and prediction skills. Children will be writing diary entries, newspaper reports and developing their creative writing skills considering the impact upon the reader.



#### Maths



In Mathematics, we will begin by recognising whole and part of a number. We will recognise and find  $1/2$ ,  $1/3$  and  $1/4$ . Unit fractions and non-unit fractions, equivalence  $1/2$  and  $2/4$ . Recognising and finding  $3/4$ . We will be working on time O'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past the hour. Telling the time to the hour and telling the time past the hour.

Minutes in an hour and hours in a day. The children will telling the time to O'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to. and quarter to.

#### Science



In Science this term the children will be learning about keeping our bodies healthy. They will be developing their scientific skills and taking part in simple experiments. Children will be making predictions and drawing conclusions from their results.

## Topic



Our Topic for this term will be 'The Great Fire of London'. We will be researching the 'Great Fire of London', writing a recount of the fire and have the opportunity to use a quill and ink. As part of their Design and Technology, children will design and make a Tudor house as part of a Tudor street scene. The Inspirational day will be on April 17th and children are invited to come into school dressed as a character from this time and will take part in a range of engaging activities.

## PE



Our PE this term will focus on developing our Athletic and team building skills. We will be sprinting, jumping for height, throwing for distance and accuracy. Team building will focus on co-operation, communication and following instructions.

## Computing



We will begin the term working on coding. The children will also learn how to create simple tunes, change the speed of the music and add instruments.

## Music



In Music the children will learn about the different elements of music and have the opportunity to explore tuned and un-tuned instruments. . The children will be learning the new terms timbre and metre.

## PSHRE



Our PSHRE focus is Health and Wellbeing, looking at how to develop a healthy body and mind. Children will begin by recognising what they are good at and setting achievable challenges for themselves.
