

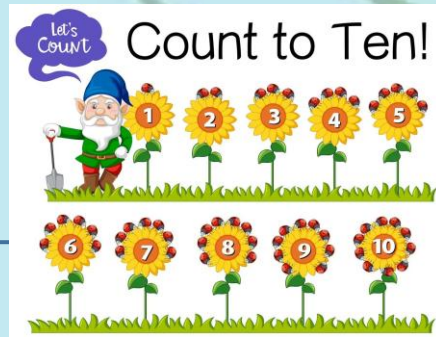
## Maths:
